## 6a. Project Update

Big Rock Creek sewer improvement project - We have been awarded the (CDBG) Community Development Block Grant of \$450,000 for wastewater improvements. This project is the rehabilitation of the sewer main pipes on the walking trail next to Lone Oak cemetery. Bid opening was December 15, 2023. We received three bids. John T. Hall constructions company was low bidder at \$1,536,125. The 36" bore under the railroad was completed. Pipe and manhole replacement was restarted the week of April 2. They are now working on the walking trail near Cornersville Road.
The Installation of a new 8-inch water line to Cornersville - This line will run 5,200 feet from Underpass Road to Beechwood Ave. We are doing it with in-house labor. Our employees have completed the pipe. It will have testing done and be put into service the week of April 8.
